It has successfully replaced the cumbersome manual eligibility process with leading technology that automates the creation, submission and processing of all types of Medicaid application forms for the City of New York Department of Social Service Nursing Home Eligibility Division, **including new applications, conversions, recertifications, status changes and financial changes.**

How the process works

EASYng™ automates the entire application process for your facility. **EASYng™** collects the data needed to complete the DSS 2921 as well as all other forms required for Long Term Care case preparation. In addition, **EASYng™** allows you to electronically submit your forms and associated scanned documentation to the City of New York for processing. Acknowledgements, responses and changes in status from the City of New York Long Term Care Unit will be available through **EASYng™** on a daily basis. There is no longer a need for express or courier services to deliver your cases to the Medicaid offices.

EASYng™ electronically prepares your Long Term Care Medicaid Applications, MA, PA and SSI Conversions, Recertifications, and Financial/Status/Demographic changes. A comprehensive interview is used to populate the various forms required for submission, eliminating the need for manual data entry.

All documents required for submission are scanned to our secure server, eliminating the need to maintain sensitive paper files while creating an “electronic folder” of forms and documentation for each client. These images along with the proper forms are submitted electronically to NYC HRA for processing.

Once submitted, **EASYng™** will return the acknowledgement from the City of New York with the official Medicaid “Clock-in” time and date stamp. Afterwards, **EASYng™** monitors your cases for responses from the City of New York. All responses are available through **EASYng™** on a daily basis. **EASYng™** also informs you that the 90-day submission window for submission or reconsideration is approaching. This process has proven to be extremely valuable in maintaining the original Medicaid “Pick-up” date.

Our automated documentation checklist allows you to ensure all the required documentation is scanned for each case according to the official Medicaid guidelines. All information collected in the electronic interview is cross-referenced to the documentation checklist to present a comprehensive selection of images to be collected.
